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PRACTICAL INFO

VISAS & PASSEPORT

Citizens from many countries do not need a visa for a tourist stay of up to 90 days.

Entry Requirements:

- Passport valid for at least 6 months after your entry date
- Return or onward ticket
- Proof of accommodation (hotel booking, invitation, etc.)

HEALTH

- No mandatory vaccines
- Do not drink tap water, it is not potable

TRADITIONAL RIAD

HEART OF THE MEDINA

✓ Perfect for an authentic Moroccan experience in a charming setting

✗ Often accessed on foot through narrow, busy souks. Not ideal for everyone



HOTEL

GUELIZ | HIVERNAGE | PALMERAIE | AGDAL

✓ A great balance between modern comfort (with pool) and ease of getting around

✗ Less authentic and usually pricier than other options



PRIVATE RENTALS

THROUGHOUT THE CITY

✓ Ideal for an immersive stay, with full freedom, just like home

✗ Be cautious: check reviews and favor central neighborhoods to avoid unpleasant surprises

AIRPORT TRANSFER

MARRAKECH → CITY CENTER

- 🚕 TAXI : 100–200 MAD depending on distance, passengers, luggage
 - 🚌 BUS ALSA – N°19: EVERY 30 MIN
→ 30 MAD per person (one way)
→ 50 MAD round-trip (valid 15 days)

GETTING AROUND THE CITY

MARRAKECH

- 🚕 TAXI : 7 MAD starting fare, then 5 MAD/km
 - 🚗 CAR RENTAL : From 250 MAD/day
 - 🚌 BUS ALSA: Pay on cash on board

GETTING OUTSIDE

OUTSIDE MARRAKECH

- 🚕 GRANDS TAXIS : Fixed rate depending on destination
- 🚌 BUS SUPRATOURS : For intercity travel
- 🚆 TRAIN ONCF : Limited to major cities



AIRPORT TAXI PRICES BY ZONE

- Zone 1 (<3 km): 100 MAD (€10)
- Zone 2 (3–5 km): 110 MAD (€11)
- Zone 3 (5–7 km): 120 MAD (€12)
- Zone 4 (7–9 km): 130 MAD (€13)
- Zone 5 (9–11 km): 140 MAD (€14)
- Zone 6 (11–13 km): 150 MAD (€15)
- Zone 7 (13–15 km): 160 MAD (€16)

JEMAA EL FNA

Vibrant heart of Marrakech, alive day & night

KOUTOUBIA

Majestic mosque with iconic minaret

- ❌ No visitor access

MADRASA BEN YOUSSEF

14th-century Quranic school

- 💰 40 MAD/person



BAHIA PALACE

A 19th-century palace showcasing Moroccan architecture

- 💰 100 MAD/person



EL BADI PALACE

Famous for hosting the “Marrakech du Rire” comedy festival

- 💰 100 MAD/person



SOUKS

Marrakech has 18 different souks

LE JARDIN SECRET

A peaceful oasis in the medina

-  100 MAD/person



SAADIAN TOMBS

Burial site of Saadian dynasty members

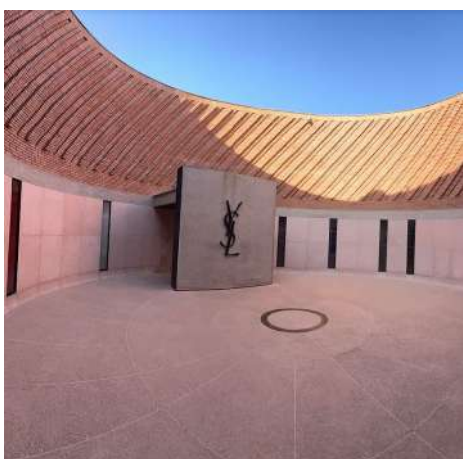
IN GUÉLIZ

ONCF TRAIN STATION

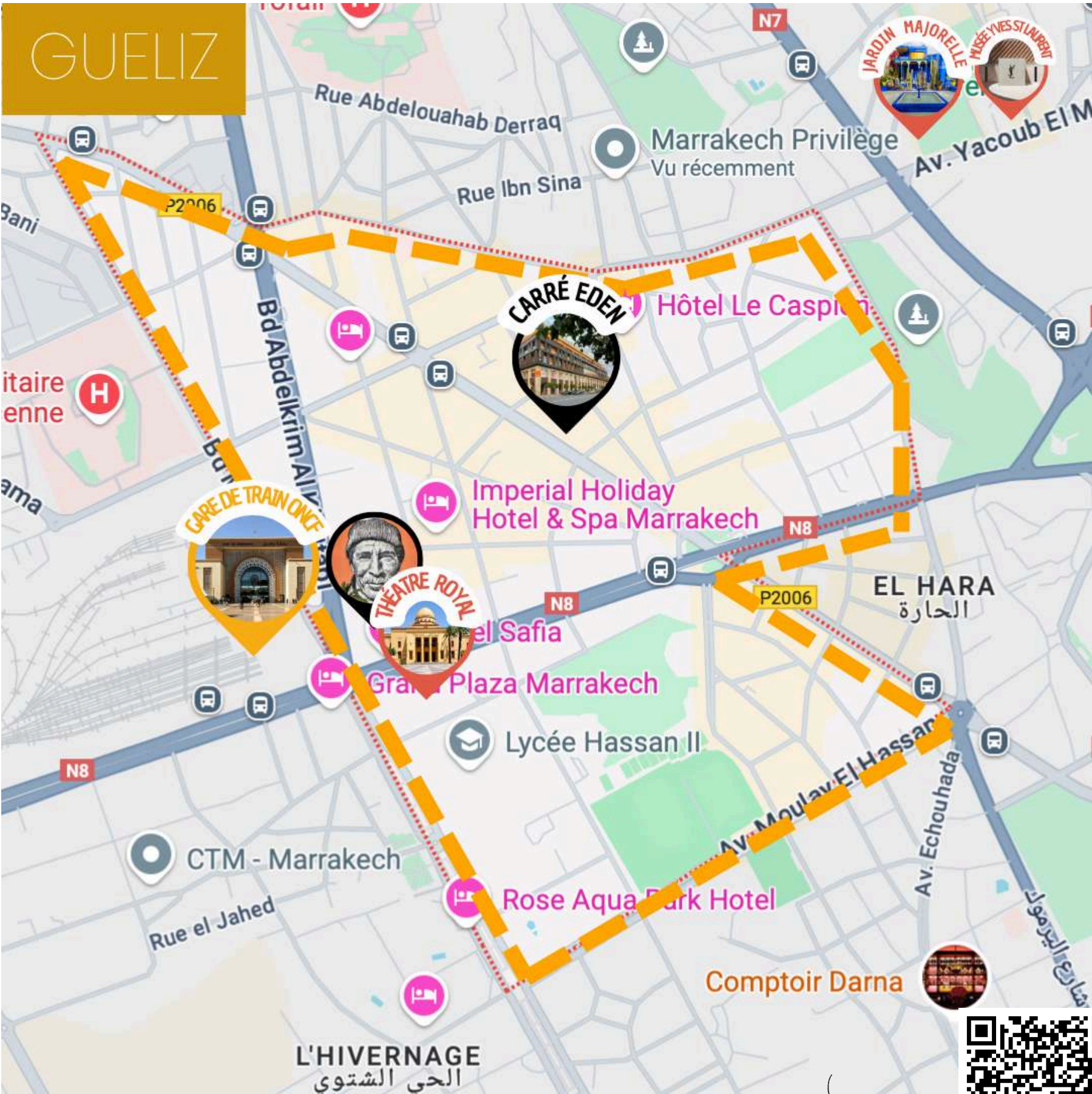
Departures to major Moroccan cities

M'AVENUE

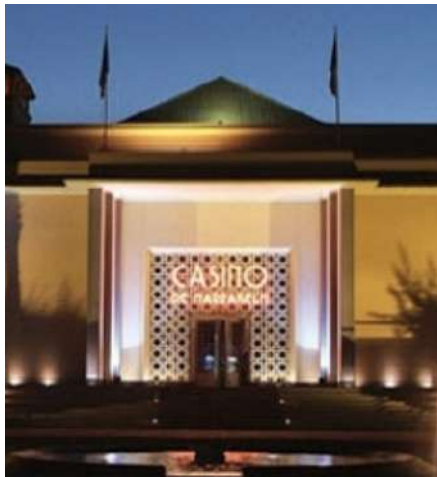
Modern avenue mixing upscale boutiques, restaurants, galleries, and artistic spaces

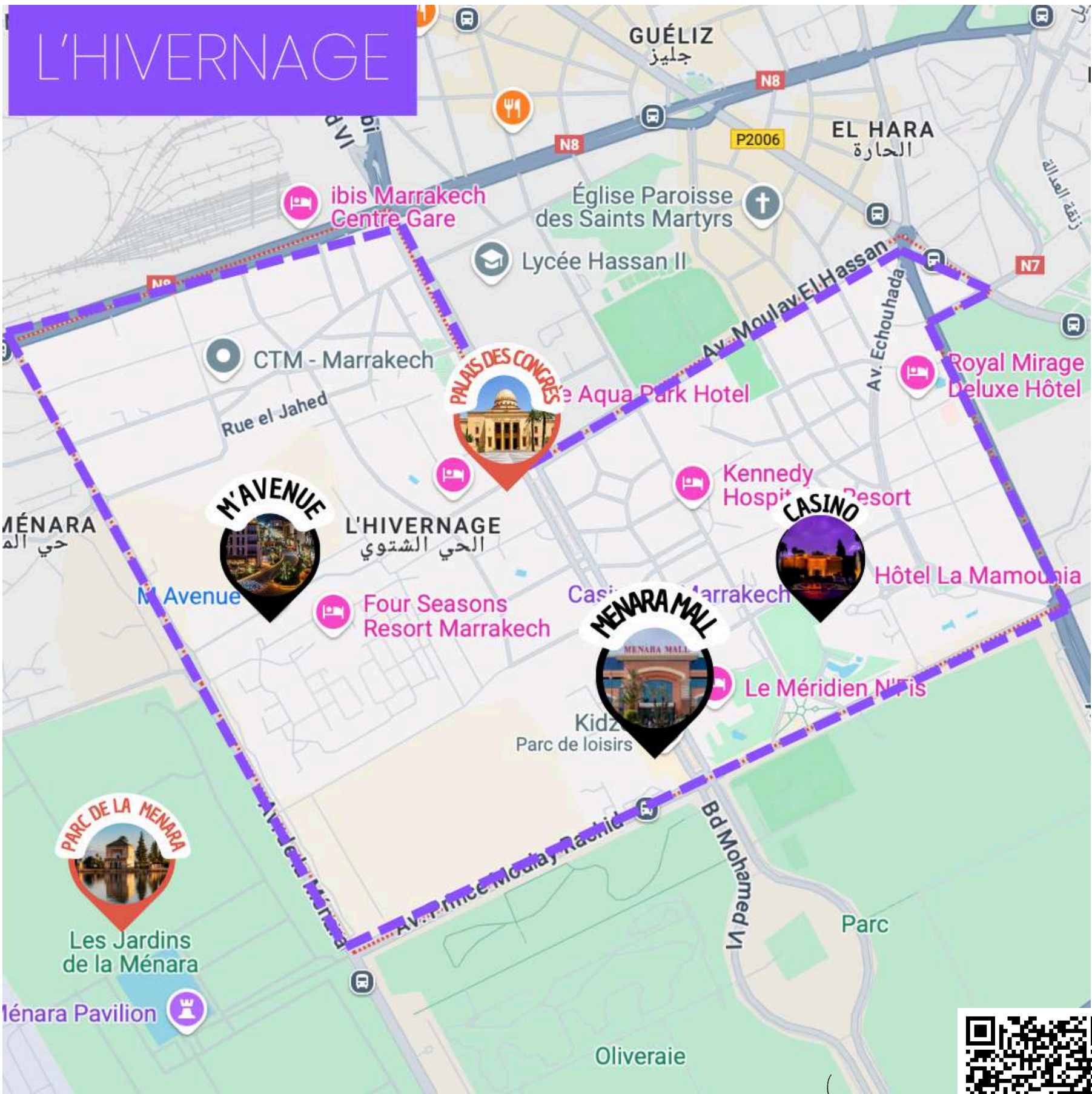


MARRAKECH CASINO

→ Perfect for travelers seeking high-end comfort and evening outings.



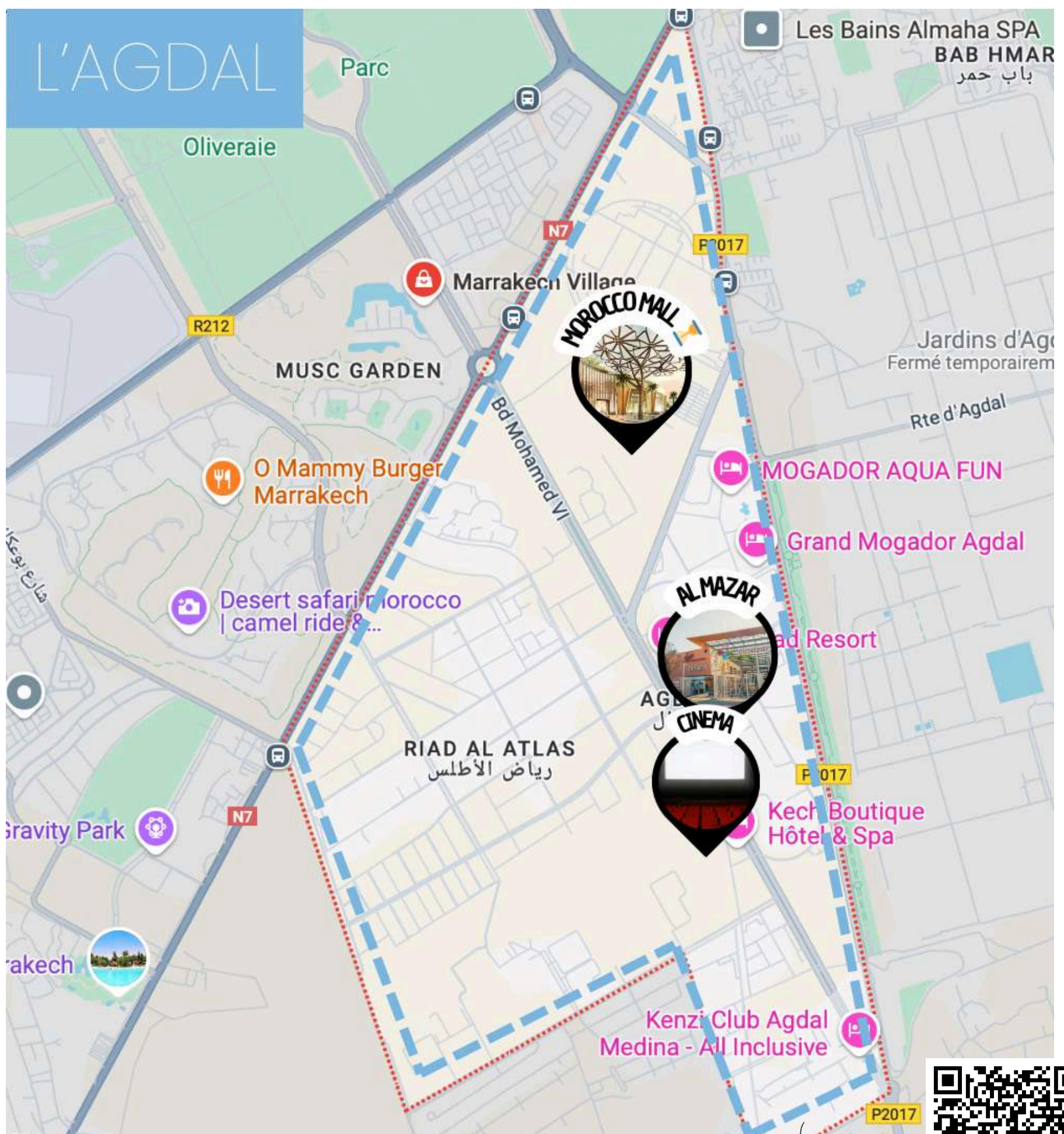
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WHAT TO SEE & DO

→ A modern shopping and leisure zone, less traditional but full of potential.



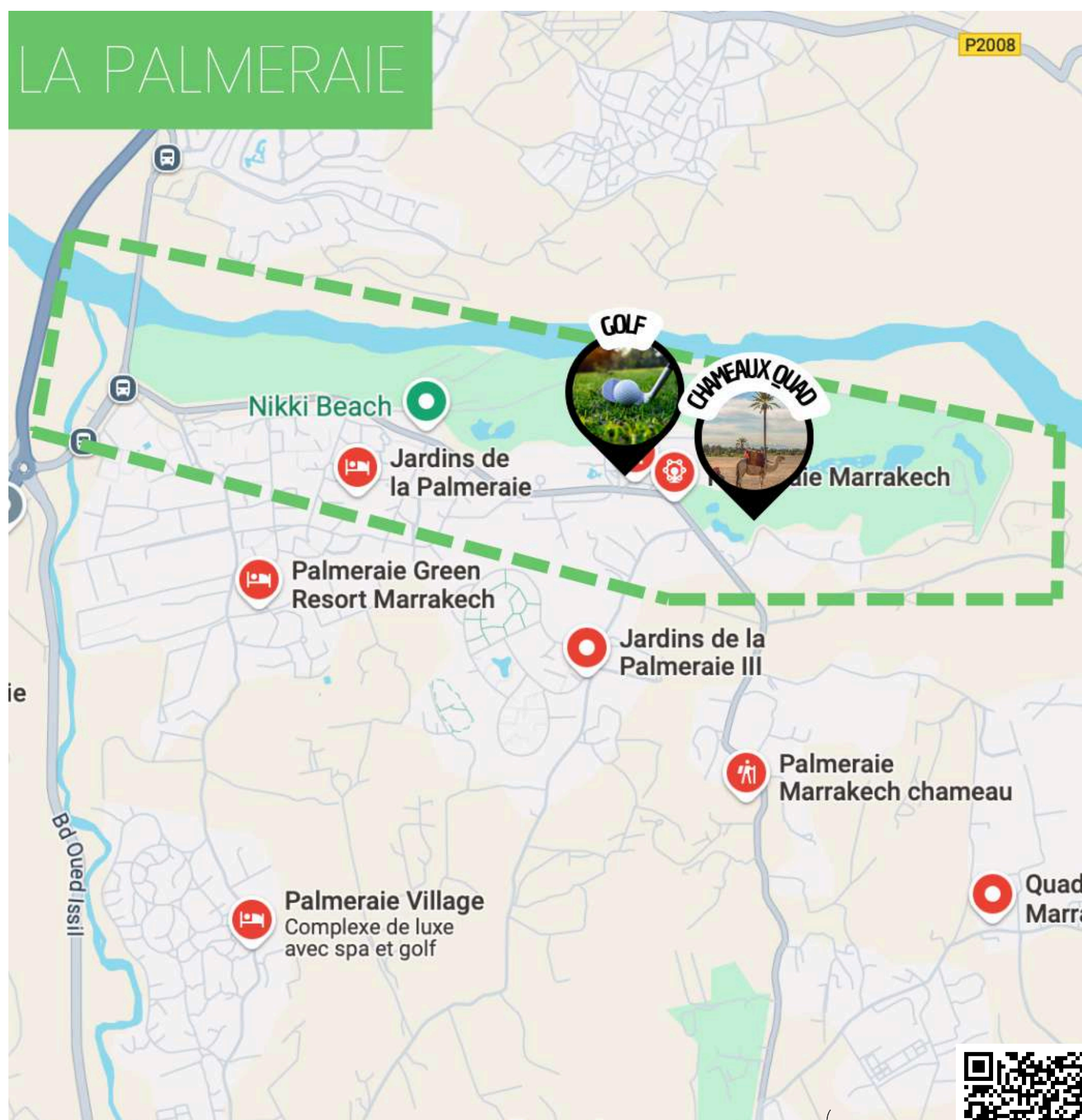

Known as “Marrakech’s Hollywood,” it houses vacation homes of celebrities. 13,000 hectares planted with palm trees since Almoravid times.

→ Ideal for outdoor activities (quads, camels, golf), photo ops & nature breaks away from the medina.

OUTSIDE MARRAKECH



AGAFAY DESERT

Rocky desert with lunar landscapes — camel rides, quad biking, or dinner under Berber tents

- 🚗 1 hour drive
 - 💰 400–700 MAD depending on activity

OURIKA VALLEY

Nature getaway at the foot of the Atlas Mountains , river walks & waterfalls

- 🚗 1.5 hours
 - 💰 200–300 MAD

OUZLOUD WATERFALLS

Morocco's most beautiful falls, home to wild monkeys

- 🚗 3 hours
 - 💰 ~350 MAD (transport + guide)

ESSAOUIRA

Former Portuguese port town with a bohemian vibe : beach, harbor & grilled fish market

- 🚗 3 hours
 - 💰 250–400 MAD

IMLIL (HIGH ATLAS)

Mountain village at 1,740m, ideal for hiking & Toubkal summit treks

- 🚗 2 hours
- 💰 250–350 MAD (transport + guide)

SPECIALITIES TO TRY



TAJINE

Chicken, beef, lamb, veggies or fish. Morocco's iconic dish. (Yes, eat it with your hands!)



COUSCOUS

Traditional Friday dish, served as a special of the day in most restaurants



PASTILLA

Sweet-savory crispy pastry filled with chicken, almonds, cinnamon



MOROCCAN BREAKFAST

A feast: msemen, harcha, baghrir, bread, eggs, olives, fresh cheese, honey, olive oil, and mint tea!



TANJIA

Marrakech specialty, slow-cooked meat in clay jars buried in hot coals

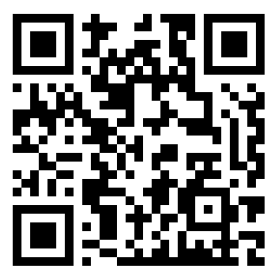
